CLEAN DRINKING WATER FOR URBAN, RURAL, NEGLECTED AND ORANG ASLI COMMUNITIES

SUMMARY OF PROJECT

This project by the Rotary Club of Kuala Lumpur DiRaja encompasses activities to identify, carry out specific needs basis assessments and selection of best solution; in collaboration with our partners-in-service, to mainly provide clean drinking water and fulfilling the basic need for water filters and water supply to deprived urban and rural, neglected and orang asli communities.

SCOPE OF PROJECT & TIMELINES

The phase 1 of the project provided for 'Diamond Water' filters fully sponsored with maintenance for 5 years, worth RM100,000 by NEP Holding and phase 2 will provide funding and expertise for construction of peripheral infrastructure including linkages to the nearest water sources to enable continuous water supply to selected communities. The community leaders will also be trained to ensure sustainability of the solution by teaching them the knowhow on maintenance and repair work. The project PHASE 2 will be carried out in stages within the reach of the club and its partner-in-service to be completed within the first quarter of 2018.

BENEFICIARIES

Among the communities benefitting from this project are 20 homes of the underprivileged in the Klang Valley and rural / indigenous communities based in Ulu Langat, Janda Baik and Kpg Bertang, Raub Pahang.
